Difficulties of Independent Seniors

Seniors want to live independently in their own homes for as long as possible.

But they experience difficulties carrying out daily living activities, such as:

- Taking medication
- Attending doctor appointments
- Eating healthy
- Getting exercise

These difficulties are due to:

- Being forgetful
- Not well organized
- Declined thought process
- Declined self-motivation / self-discipline

Inability to properly carry out daily living activities will force the senior out of their home, possibly into a nursing home.

Difficulties of Family Caregivers

Family caregivers want their senior loved one to have good quality of life.

Family caregivers help their seniors as much as they can, but many family caregivers are stressed out:

- From all the effort and time they put in to help the senior
- From worrying about the safety and well-being of the senior
- From addressing their busy life: own family, personal life, work life, and senior.

If a family caregiver cannot obtain assistance, some aspects of their life will suffer.

The CareMate Service is an innovative new type of electronic assistive service. It provides assistance to both seniors and family caregivers.

Assistance for Seniors

The CareMate Service is an easy to use electronic service that helps seniors to continue to live independently in their own homes, for longer.



The senior receives automatic verbal reminders and messages over their telephone.

Examples of reminders and messages:

- “Time to take your medication.”
- “Doctor’s appointment in one hour.”
- “Grandson’s birthday is on Tuesday.”
- “It’s a beautiful day!”
- “Time for your afternoon walk.”
- “Today is the last day to use your 20% off coupon at the grocery store.”
- “Remember to turn off the stove.”



The family caregiver uses a personal computer to set up the Service with the reminders for the senior.

Assistance for Family Caregivers

The CareMate Service is an electronic service that helps make life easier, and better, for family caregivers.



The family caregiver uses a cellphone, smartphone or personal computer to receive valuable services:

1. Receive on-the-spot alerts, such as
 - Senior did not take afternoon pills
 - Senior has not answered telephone all day
2. View daily compliance information on the senior, contained in a database, such as:
 - Senior took evening pills
 - Senior saw family doctor today

In addition, the biggest assistance that the Service provides to the family caregiver is carrying out automatic caregiver tasks with the senior. – This results in less for the family caregiver to do, daily.
